#### TAX LEVY ORDINANCE

#### PALATINE TOWNSHIP ROAD DISTRICT

#### ORDINANCE NO. 07-14 RD

AN ORDINANCE levying taxes for all road purposes for Palatine Township Road District in Cook County, Illinois, for the tax year 2014, collectable in 2015.

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Board of Trustees of Palatine Township, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That the Highway Commissioner of Palatine Township Road District on December 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2014 does hereby determine and declare that the sum of two million six hundred ten thousand dollars (\$2,610,000.00) are hereby levied upon all property subject to taxation within the Road District as that property is assessed and equalized, in order to meet and defray all the necessary expenses and liabilities of the Road District as required by statute or voted by the people in accordance with the law, for such purposes as defined in the General Road Fund for fiscal year 2015.
