Lift-Equipped Mini-Bus Service

Service provided: Buses provide curb to curb service anywhere within the Palatine Township boundaries for residents who are 60 and over, and / or disabled.

Service area:

Palatine Township encompasses a 36-square mile area northwest of Chicago. Our boundaries are:

Wilke Road to the east
Huntington/Freeman Road to the west
Lake-Cook Road to the north
Central Road to the south

This service also includes rides to **Arlington Heights & Rolling Meadows** on **Monday through Friday for medical appointments**.

Hours:

The bus service is available Monday through Friday 8:00 am to 3:00 p.m. (closed holidays and weekends). Earliest appointment destination is 9:00 a.m. **Cost:** A one-way ride is \$2.00.

Mandatory pre-registration:

Documentation of age and residency <u>must be provided</u> and if under 60, documentation of disability is required to complete the registration process.

Palatine Township Subsidized Taxi Program



Service area:

❖ The ride must originate or terminate in Palatine Township.

Voucher cards:

- ❖ Included with registration for our bus service for seniors 60 and over and or permanently disabled persons who are permanent residents of Palatine Township.
- You must visit us at the Palatine Township office to obtain your voucher card.
- Each card will be individualized with your name, client ID number and your photo.
- All cards are assigned to individuals and are not to be used by another. Violators will lose all program privileges.
- The taxi meter together with the card swipe will document both pickup and drop off locations.
- Cards may only be used with approved taxi companies as set forth by Palatine Township.
- ❖ 10 card swipes, each worth \$4.00, will be auto loaded on to your card at the beginning of each month.
- After the card is swiped you are responsible for paying the balance of the fare and tips.
- No rides will be carried over to the next month.
- ❖ You may not use more than one swipe per one-way trip.
- If your card is lost or stolen, you must immediately notify Palatine Township.
- ❖ Replacement cards will be \$5.00 each.
- If your name, address or any contact details change, you must notify Palatine Township to advise of the new details as soon as possible.

Appointment Information Needed:

- Appointment time.
- Length of appointment.
- Appointment address and phone number.
- Specific drop off and pick up point.
- Any aids used: wheel chair, walker, need of lift, etc...

Bus arrival time:

All appointments will receive a 20 to 30 minute window of time for pickup.

All clients are expected to be ready when the bus arrives. The driver will not wait more than 5 minutes beyond arrival.
